

## MOTEBOOK COVER

Notebook cover

Finished size is about 10 x 15

Fits a 9 ¾ x 7 ½ composition notebook

## Supplies


1/2 yard of fabric for outside and flaps

Coordinating lining fabric, if desired

Small piece of fabric for appliqués

Heat n Bond or Steam a Seam

Piece of batting just a bit larger than the notebook



Begin by tracing around the composition notebook on wrong side of cover fabric

Trim excess, leaving at least ½ inch all around



For initial or heart, trace onto Steam a Seam or Heat n Bond

Place appliqué image on front of folder cover and zig zag in place



Cut lining fabric the same size as the outer folder piece – I used Kona white



Inside flaps

5 inches wide by the width of folder piece

Turn under one of the long edges and hem

Cut a piece of batting a little larger than the traced composition notebook fabric



Layer wrong side of lining over batting, side flaps wrong sides facing right side of lining, folder outside piece right side facing right side of flaps



Sew about 1/8 inch away from traced line, leaving an opening for turning along the bottom

Trim to ¼ seam allowance



Turn right side out and then top stitch close to the edge

Make sure your seam allowance is small and same with top stitching or it won't fit!



I also did one with a heart appliqué
