

SODA CAN HUGGIES

A couple of things:

- Read all of the instructions before your begin.
- Sew with $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances
- RST means right sides together

Fabrics Needed

- Fabric: 2- $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " (1-for main fabric 1 for lining)
- Contrasting fabric (for piping) fat quarter
- Insul-Bright®: 1- $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ "
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard of 4/32 cording (found with drapery supplies)

Cutting Instructions

For piping: cut 1 strip on bias 2" x 14"

Sewing Instructions

1. Make piping using bias strip and cording. Center piping cord on fabric strip and sew close to cord. Trim seam to $\frac{1}{4}$ ".
2. Place right side of main fabric on top of Insul-Bright®
3. Stitch piping to top of main fabric.
4. Lay lining with RST to main fabric, stitch across top, press and edge stitch.
5. Fold in half with RST, sew along side and bottom. Trim seam and zig zag.
6. Fold bottom to match sides, sew 1" from point. Double stitch and trim.



7. Turn right side out.

Tip: to create your own, measure your bottle around and change measurements to meet your needs.
