

A couple of things:

- This pattern makes 2 pot holders

- Sew with 1/4" seam allowances

Supplies needed

- Fabric: 1 fat quarter

- Contrasting fabric (for binding) fat quarter

- Insul-Bright®: 1/4 yard

Cutting Instructions

1. Main Fabric: cut 4- 6" squares

- 2. Contrasting fabric- make 2 ½" bias binding to go around perimeter of two pot holders. Approximately 65" Fold wrong sides together and press to complete bias binding.
- 3. Insul-Bright® cut 4- 6" squares

Sewing Instructions

- 1. Place 2 layers of Insul-bright® on top of one piece of main fabric. Main fabric should have right sides down. Wrong side exposed to Insul- Bright®
- 2. Lay second piece of main fabric with right sides up on top of layered Insul-Bright® and 6" square.
- 3. Repeat with second set of 6" squares and Insul-bright®
- 4. Sew bias binding to perimeter of layered 6" squares. Raw edges of bias binding to raw edges of layered 6" squares. Turn binding over the layers and sew to finish the edges.
- 5. Leftover bias binding can be used as a loop for the pot holders.

 Use approximately 6" or less to make a loop. Tuck in all raw edges, including ends and sew closed. Make a loop and sew to completed pot holder.
