# CLOUD PILOWS

# Materials Needed

1 fat quarter for the pillow front

1 fat quarter for the pillow back


embroidery floss (optional)

polyfil or preferred stuffing


coordinating thread

*all seams are 1/4" unless otherwise stated*

Place the clouds right sides together and pin in place.



Starting at the bottom, sew around the clouds leaving about a 3" hole in the straight bottom for turning. Make sure to backstitch at the beginning and end.




Clip notches in the seam allowance all around the clouds, being careful not to clip through the stitches.



Turn right side out, being sure push out all of the curves. Press with a hot iron.

Stuff with polyfil until you are happy with the puffiness.

Hand sew the opening closed using a blind stitch or a whipstitch.



Enjoy your happy little cloud and make more to share the happiness!
